CAMPUS NEWS ROUND-UP

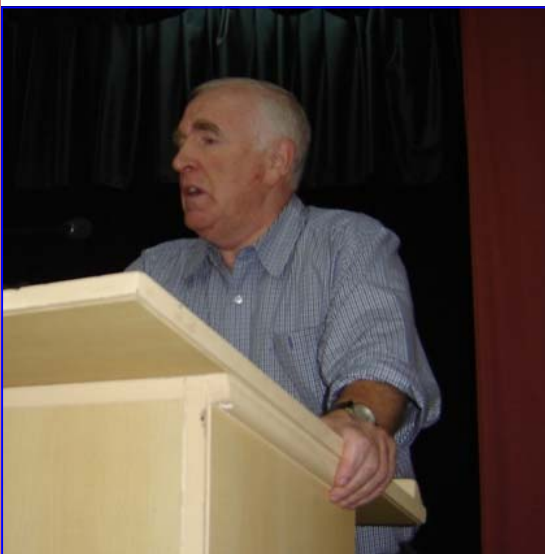
