- 2) a) Find the distance of 7 planets and Sun from the Earth.
b) Arrange them in tabular form in ascending order.
c) Write the number names of each distance in both Indian and International systems.
d) Write each distance in expanded form.
- 3) a) Create a robot using different 2-D shapes.
b) Use the cut outs of different coloured chart papers and paste in your notebook to create the robot.
c) Give a name to your robot.
