Class: V



Subject: English

1. Read the story book *Around the World in Eighty Days* and use the following story map to complete the book review.



2. Sketch a pen picture of two of your favourite characters and write what you liked about them.
3. Find out 20 new words from the story and create your own *Syno-Book* (a booklet of words and two synonyms each).

Subject: Mathematics

1. Use the internet to find the list of 10 populated countries. Take down the data from the statistics of the year 2012. Then do as directed:
 - a) Write their population in both Indian and International system of numeration.
 - b) Arrange them in ascending and descending order.

c) Round off the numbers to the nearest 1,000.

2. Note down the types of angles made by the hands of clock or watch at different times and record in a table.
3. Note the maximum and minimum temperature of any 5 different states from the News channels for at least 10 days. Record your observation. Identify the coldest and hottest day of each state. Find the difference in the maximum and minimum temperatures.
4. Visit a fruit market with your parents and make a list of prices of various fruits. After a month, visit the market again and calculate the difference in prices in one month and arrange in ascending order. Name the fruit whose prices have changed the maximum.

Subject: E.V.S

1. Collect newspaper articles/headlines or search on internet for information on any natural calamity, rail mishap, aircraft mishap, etc., in the recent years and write a note in A4 size sheet.
2. Collect some wrappers of food items (05 at least) like health drinks, juices, wafers, chocolates, etc. Paste them in A4 size sheet and write down the nutritional value of each.
