The school has a dedicated Behavioural Counsellor and collaborates with top career counselling experts from the NCR to guide students toward personal growth and future success.

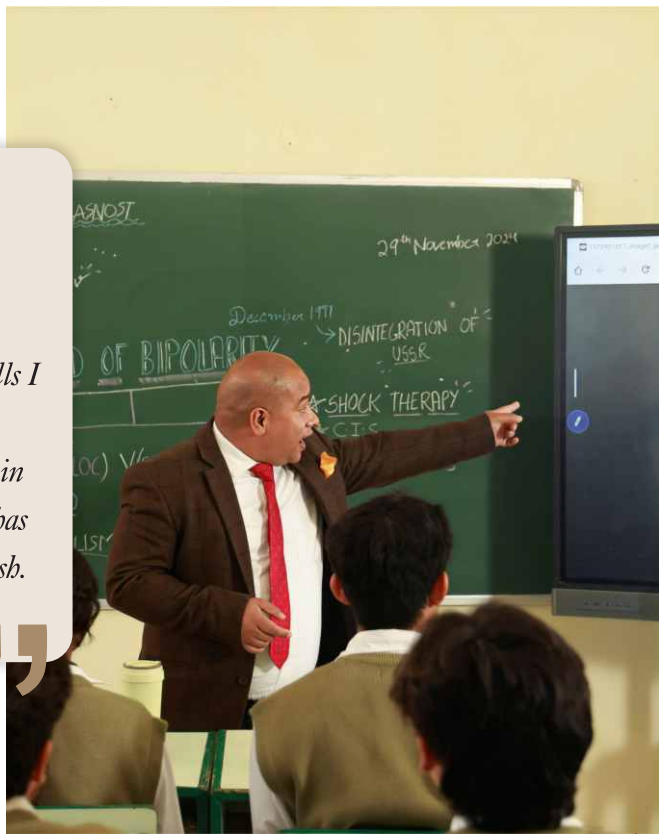

Research projects develop essential life skills, including time management, organisation, and effective communication. Students learn to present findings clearly and confidently, preparing for future academic and professional opportunities. Collaborative research further enhances teamwork and the ability to work well with others - skills vital in any career.

Our campus provides abundant opportunities for research in Astronomy, Ecology, Solar Power Generation, Water Harvesting, Soil Studies, and Bio-diversity Mapping, including trees, plants, birds, butterflies, and moth counts. These projects cultivate independent learners and critical thinkers, equipping students with the tools to succeed in an increasingly complex world.



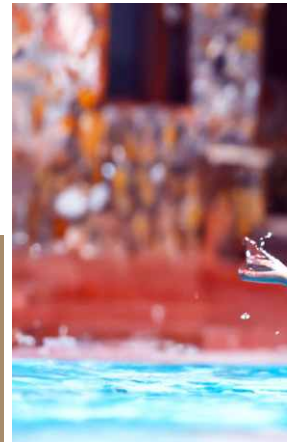


## SPORTS ON CAMPUS

# *Life Skills* and Future Skills

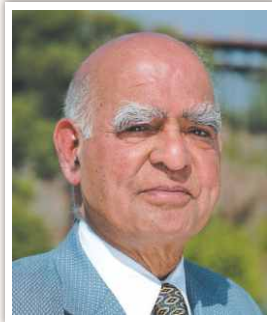
In an era marked by uncertainty, it is increasingly important for our students to acquire advanced life and future skills. At The Sagar School, our academic leadership have developed a unique programme designed to prepare students for the challenges ahead. This programme equips them with essential skills for thriving in the world beyond school, ensuring they are ready to navigate an ever-evolving future.

## *Nurturing and Well-being*

Campus life is supported by a happy and friendly community, relaxed yet purposeful, nurturing a genuine sense of family.

The school provides separate air-conditioned hostels for boys and girls, with rooms shared by 4-6 students. Each student is allocated a bed, a personal cupboard, and a workstation. Common rooms with high-speed internet cater to both leisure and study needs.

Housekeeping, laundry, maintenance, and catering are managed professionally, with meals offered in Indian, Continental, and Chinese cuisines, including vegetarian and non-vegetarian options. Menus are planned bi-weekly by a dietitian and a committee of students and teachers. The campus Health Centre is staffed by experienced nurses, with priority access to Medanta and Max Hospitals when necessary.
